

Stay Connected with Zoom Video Visits

To help you stay in touch with loved ones while hospital visitation is limited, we are using Zoom Video Conferencing. Patients can ask a nurse to set up a video conference for them. Or, if you are a friend or family member, you can call the patient's unit and our nursing team will set up a call.

How to Zoom

Make sure your device has Zoom software. Zoom runs best on a computer (Mac or PC) but it also works on tablets and smartphones.).

If you don't have a Zoom account, go to **https://zoom.us/download** and click **Download** under **"Zoom Client for Meetings"**. The application will automatically download when you start your first Zoom Meeting. Once the installation completes, you will be put into a test meeting.

You can join your video conference one of two ways:

- Five minutes before your visit, click on the link in your invitation.
- Or, go to **join.zoom.us** and enter the Meeting ID provided to you by the medical staff. When prompted, type in the Meeting ID #.

Participant controls are located in the lower left of the Zoom screen:

• To test your audio, click on the **^ symbol** next to microphone icon on the control panel. Then, click on **Test Speakers & Microphone.**



- Mute/Unmute by clicking on the microphone at the far left
- Turn the camera on or off by clicking Start/Stop Video
- Click on **Invite** other participants to add someone to the conversation.
- Click on **Participants** to see who's on the call.
- Click on **Share Screen** to share your screen.

Contact with loved ones is important to recovery. We are doing all we can to facilitate interaction while visitation is limited due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
