- Transmen seeking masculinizing (FTM) procedures
- Transwomen seeking feminizing (MTF) procedures
- Non-binary individuals seeking procedures to make their bodies more congruent with their gender identity

Our surgeons will work with you extensively, customizing your care to fit your goals and needs.

Before undergoing gender affirmation surgery, patients should be physically and emotionally healthy, with no major medical issues, such as diabetes, hypertension or obesity, that may impede the procedure or its recovery. Patients that smoke will need to quit prior to their surgery, as smoking can significantly delay and complicate recovery.

Procedures

These are a few of the most sought-after procedures in gender alignment surgery available at MarinHealth™ Medical Center.

- Top Surgery: Chest masculinizing surgery
- Phalloplasty: Surgery to create male genitalia
- Facial Feminization: Surgery to create more feminine facial features
- Breast Augmentation: Chest feminizing surgery
- Vaginoplasty: Surgery to create female genitalia
- Body Contouring: Altering the shape of the body to be more feminine (fat grafting to buttocks and hips) or masculine (liposuction of hips)
