For more than seventy years, MarinHealth has provided exceptional healthcare services to the region in a compassionate and healing environment.

As one of the top 5% of hospitals in the nation, MarinHealth has expanded access, improved patient care and outcomes, attracted expert physicians, and grown key service lines. As a result, MarinHealth has experienced a significant increase in patient volumes as well as notable growth in critical service lines over the past five years:

The hospital's Redwood Pavilion, built in 1952 as the original hospital campus, is facing a state seismic deadline, and no longer aligns with the modern healthcare infrastructure standards that our patients and staff deserve.

**To sustain, improve, and expand access to quality healthcare for the North Bay community and beyond, it is time for us to expand our campus.**

# Now is the time for Building on Excellence

Investing in the health of Marin will include expanding the hospital campus through:

Construction of a new pavilion with:

- 30+ private patient rooms
- 5-7 operating rooms/endoscopic operating rooms
- 2-5 cardiac catheterization/ electrophysiology labs
- 1 nuclear medicine suite

In addition, project will include:

- Expansion of the Emergency Department
- Redesign of the main entrance lobby in the Cedar Pavilion
- Construction of a new parking garage
- Relocation of core services (pharmacy, lab and nutrition services) from the Redwood Pavilion to the Cedar Pavilion
- Flexible space, ensuring MarinHealth can continue to grow and meet the evolving needs of the community
