The Medical Center's inpatient and outpatient services offer crisis intervention, evaluation, and treatment 24/7, 365 days a year. In addition to psychiatric care, patients receive full medical services from the caring and committed Behavioral Health team. The program is continuing to expand with additional offerings to serve the needs of the community through a variety of outpatient-based programs.
